### Retention & Graduation Rates

The majority of ACMin students during the years reported attended the college part-time. Further, transient student enrollment numbers are not included in the numbers reported. ACMin retention rates for part-time students are higher than average for other private institutions. As ACMin continues to expand its program offerings and works to complete campus development, the expectation is that the numbers of full-time residential students will increase. In addition, ACMin’s recent approval for Distance Education programs allows it to attract students in different areas and those in need of more flexible scheduling options.
